Due to a production error, a portion of text was omitted from the beginning of the fourth and final paragraph of section 3.1. Currently, the paragraph begins as follows:

‘($n = 25$) had more than six trips by air in the last three years, including 7.56% ($n = 9$) who had more than ten trips.’

However, the following is the correct beginning to the paragraph, with the omitted portion highlighted in bold.

Third—reported environmental footprint.
Conservatively, 10%–20% of respondents reported

relatively high environmental footprint and 10%–20% indicated very low environmental footprint. From the surveyed respondents, 21.01% ($n = 25$) had more than six trips by air in the last three years, including 7.56% ($n = 9$) who had more than ten trips.
